


Who we are and what we do







## What is a Free City?

We define "Free Cities" as self-governing territories that uphold individual rights and freedoms.

Free Cities usually have a special legal status within their host state which grants them autonomy to make decisions that affect their local community.

We are working to create a world where a multitude of freer jurisdictions offer people the choice to pursue a better life within societies that better align to their values.





### **Citizen Choice**

For historical reasons, the world has converged on a small number of governance models.

While policies differ, there is little variety in the tools governments use to raise funds, deliver public services, administer justice, regulate land, maintain security and operate their financial systems.

By working with partners that seek to innovate in one or more of these core areas, we aim to give citizens of the world more choice in the rules that govern their lives.

- 4. Engage decision makers






## 1. Media and Resources

We use social media, articles and our podcast to spread messages about Free Cities to a wide audience.

## 2. Annual Conference

Every year we host the <u>Liberty in Our Lifetime</u> conference where speakers share updates on Free Cities-aligned projects.

The in-person connections that this event generates help build a strong global Free Cities community capable of bringing about real change.

270 people from across the world attended our 2022 event on the theme "Parallel Structures for Progress".



# 3. Project Directory

The Free Cities Foundation maintains a Free Communities Directory featuring freedom-oriented projects that allow settlers and investors to access detailed and up-to-date information about places they can move to or invest in.




